

SAFEGUARDS RELATING TO STAFF

- No candidate with a criminal record of sexual and/or physical violence has been recruited for any position within the school.
- At the time of being given the appointment letter, all candidates are presented with a copy of the teacher's guidelines, and are required to sign it in acceptance.
- Class attendance is taken twice by the class teacher, once in the morning and once after the recess.
- Security in classrooms is constantly monitored with the teachers doing a head count of the children present and recording it in the log book of the respective class.
- Lady Housekeeping Staff has been deputed outside washrooms. The selected teaching staff remains on duty when the school begins, disperses and during break time to ensure safe movement of the students.
- The school has a POCSO committee as per the directives of the CBSE comprising, School Principal, School Counsellor, Teacher Representatives and Student Representatives.
- First Aid kit and basic medical aid are available and all teaching and non-teaching staff are aware of them

AWARENESS CREATION AND SENSITIZATION PROGRAM

- Students workshop on Good and Bad Touch are conducted for all the Primary and Middle school students by the School Counsellor and Special Educators.
- Student sessions on aggressive behaviour, peer pressure, career counselling, etc
- Special sessions are designed by the special educators for children with special needs in
 - order to educate them about good and bad touch and prepare them for life beyond school.
 - Videos on preventing child sexual abuse are uploaded on smart classes and website for the perusal of students and parents respectively.
 - Surprise checks are conducted to ensure that students do not carry prohibited material to
 - school such as alcohol, cigarettes, sharp objects, weapons, drugs and electronic gadgets.
